

The General Post Office

The General Post Office was built in 1849; however significant increases have been made later. There was 3 branch Post Offices in British government, one at the Railway Station and two in the city, in Moti Bazar and Lahori Mandi. Pillar letter-boxes had been installed at different areas of the city, and they were opened three times in a day for collect the mails.
