1. Lohari Gate Muslim Masjid

Muslim Masjid is a beautiful architectural building, located outside the Lohari Gate and within Walled City of Lahore. Lahori Gate is one of the thirteen gates of the Walled City of Lahore. The name also traces back its roots to the language of Urdu, in which, "Lohar" means Blacksmith. This could be another reason for naming it this way. However, there are no concrete evidences that blacksmiths had ever lived or worked here.

Muslim Masjid is widely considered to be one of Lahore's most iconic landmarks. It falls in the category of old buildings in Lahore. Built with red clay burnt bricks gives an impressively view and represent Islamic art and heritage.

Different famous and busy bazaars are located near the Muslim Mosque including Urdu Bazar, Shah Alam market, Azam Market.
