The Tomb of Hazrat Syed Jan Muhammad Hazuri

The shrine of Hazrat Syed Jan Muhammad Hazuri is located at Garhi Shahu, on Allama Iqbal Road. The saint was surnamed 'Hazuri' as the people believed that he could be admitted to a secrete place where the Holy Prophet of Islam was visible. The saint died in 1708 A.D. The walled enclosure of the shrine has two domes in the form of an arched gateway.

The chonogram inscribed in the Persian language on the tomb reads: "The is the tomb of Jan Muhammad of profound learning who was praised for his profound love of the holy Prophet Muhammad (PBUH), and after death the lover and the beloved have joined".

The famous Hazuri Bagh in front of the Badshahi Masjid was named after him. The walled enclosure of the shrine has two domes in the form of an arched gateway.
