

Tomb of Abdul Ghani

On the north side of Baghbanpura Main Bazaar, the tomb of Shah Abdul Ghani Qadri is located. It is in a close proximity to the tomb of Hazrat Madhu Lal Hussain. The tomb is situated on a slight eminence, on the right (east) of Abdul Ghani Road. A green gateway resting on two concrete pillars marks the entrance to an enormous graveyard, and a path leads to the mosque and tomb. In a sense the feeling of desolation experienced in the vast graveyard portrays the reality of present day fleeting life. Shah Abdul Ghani was among the closest disciples and companions of Hazrat Mian Mir. The saint belonged to Qadri silsila. His Urs is held in the last week of March, after Mela Chiraghan held in the nearby tomb of Madhu Lal Hussain.
