During the visit of fort mostly we ignored to look quadrangle apparently known as Akbari Mahal, in Sikh times it known as Akbari Mahal however mostly it refer to Jahangir. It belongs in any case to the early Mughal period, as is obvious from the two rows of buildings along the east and west sides of the quadrangle which are distinguished by porticoes of red sandstone with broad eaves supported on brackets in which figures of elephants, lions and peacocks have been introduced.
