(Mirza Abu'l Hasan) died in 1641 A.D. (1051 A.H.). Asif Khan left behind a great wealth the

Emperor. Shahjan (his son in Law) built Asaf Khan Tomb which is situated on the west side of

the Jilaukhana (which means reception) of Jahangir's mausoleum. It lies in a square

garden, which is enclosed by high wall made up a solid masonry. The tomb was constructed with

precious decorated stones and sculptures. During the Sikh dynasty Ranjit Singh removed these

precious stones and sculptures, to beautify Amritsar.
