Chitta Gate

Chitta Gate is situated close to the Wazir Khan Mosque, on the eastern side. It appears that it

was the entrance of the outer premises of the Mosque. As it is part of the Mosque planning, its

date of construction is the same as that of the Mosque i.e. 1631 AD. The gate is about 16 feet

wide and 30 feet high in shape of an arch. It is no more in a good state of preservation. It is

heavily encroached upon by vendors. The monument is under the control of the Augaf

Department of the Government of Punjab.
