CPL has approximately 5000 books both in Urdu and English on different subjects like computer science, mysticism, Iqbaliat, Quaid e azam, history of Pakistan, Islamic history, philosophy, Islam, Social Sciences, Natural Sciences, Politics, Urdu & English literature, text books and children's books. CPL has very rare collection on education from 1800 to 2014 for researchers.

Children Section have a rich collection of books including 3D & animated books and complete collection of kalaam publications, Oxford's children publications, bestselling kids series and a good collection of basic Islamic knowledge for children.

Standard books on various subjects are being continually acquired on the demand of library users. Chughtai public library has special focus on CSS exam preparation material.

Reference section is located at ground floor with wide range of reference material i.e. encyclopedia, dictionaries, atlases, etc. It provides reference services to researchers and general users.

Chughtai Public Library has an archive of local newspapers both in Urdu and English. The CPL has maintained record of newspapers from November, 4 2013 to onward of different newspapers.

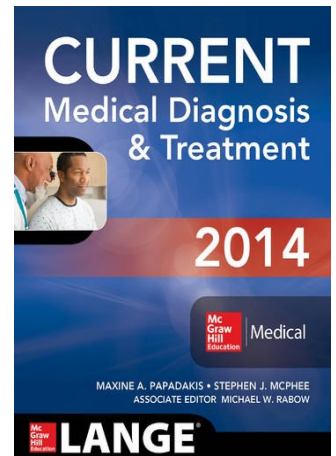
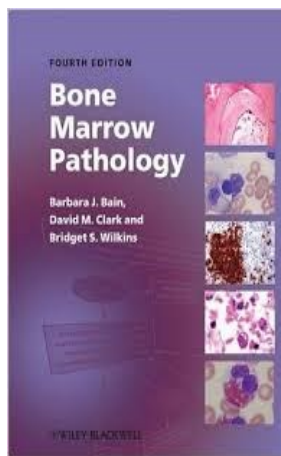
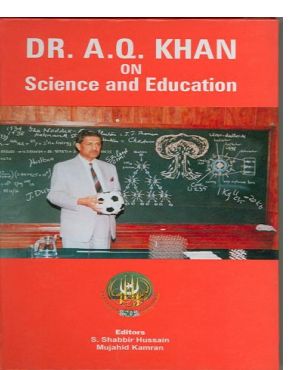
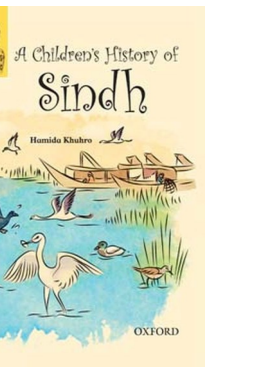
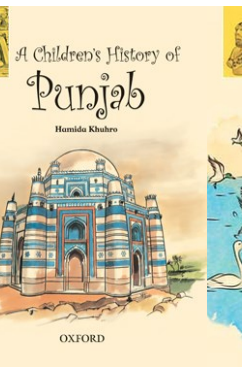
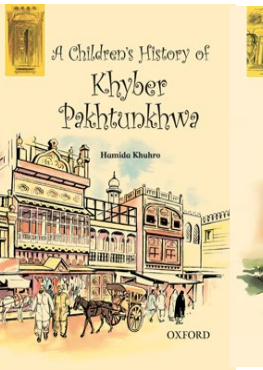
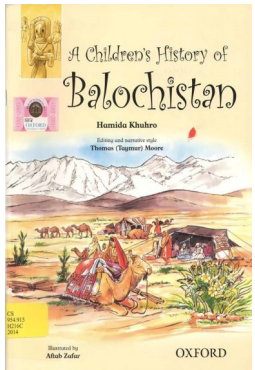
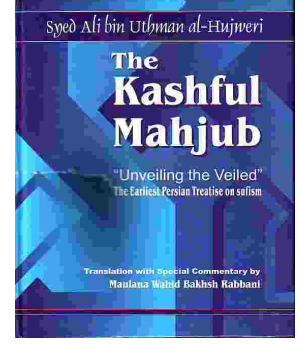
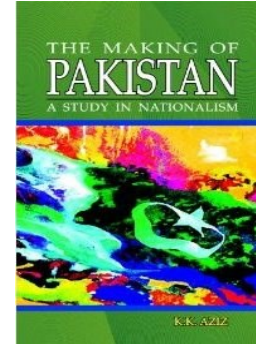
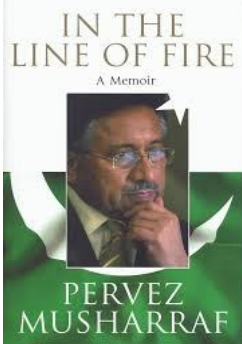
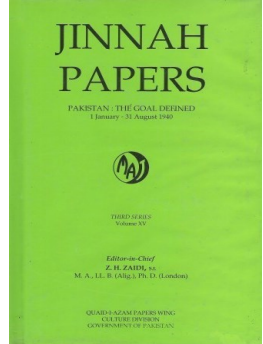
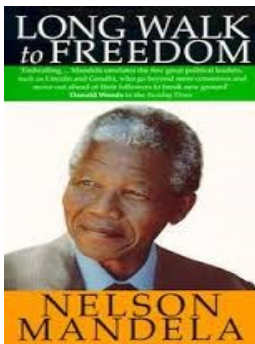
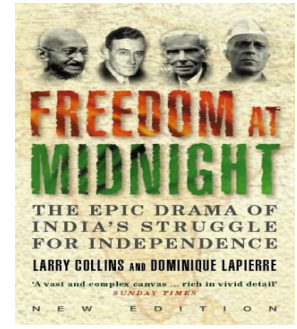
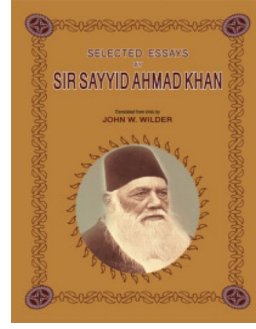
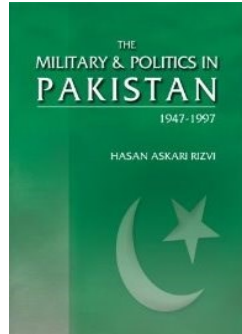
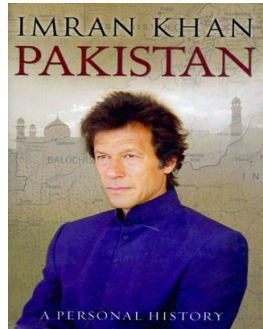
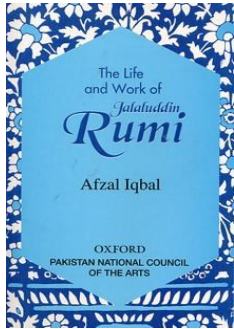
### Internet Search Strategies

OPERATOR	EXAMPLE	EXPLANATION
<b>AND</b> Document must have both words (or both phrases)	Copyright <b>AND</b> moral-rights	Will <b>narrow</b> your search because search results will include all documents that contain <b>both</b> the first term and the second term.
<b>OR</b> Document can have either word (or either phrase)	Tobacco <b>OR</b> cigarettes	Will <b>expand</b> your search because search results will include all documents that contain either the first term or the second term or both.
<b>NOT</b> Document must have first term. Must not have second  <i>* use very carefully because may exclude lots of useful information.</i>	love <b>NOT</b> war	Will exclude an idea/concept from your search because it will find documents that contain the first word, but do not contain the second.  NOT is helpful if you notice a recurring topic in your retrieval that is not relevant to your topic.
<b>ADJ</b> Forces the computer to search for words in a specified order.	obsessive <b>adj</b> compulsive	Will find results where <i>obsessive</i> <b>immediately precedes</b> <i>compulsive</i>

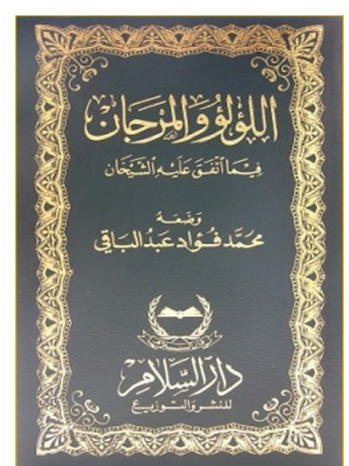
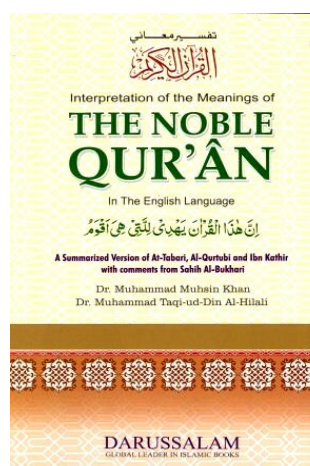
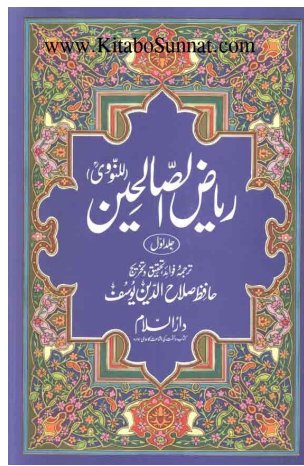
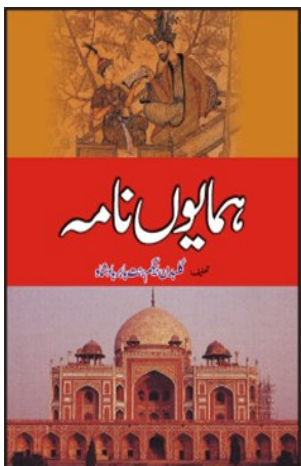
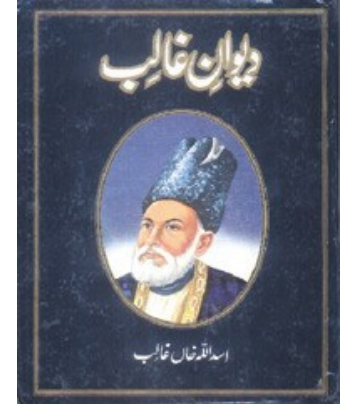
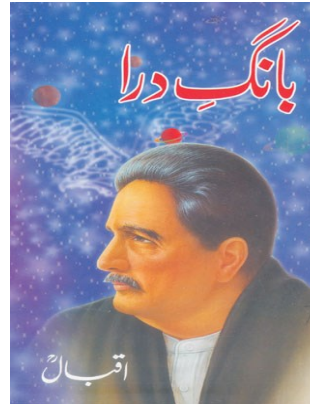
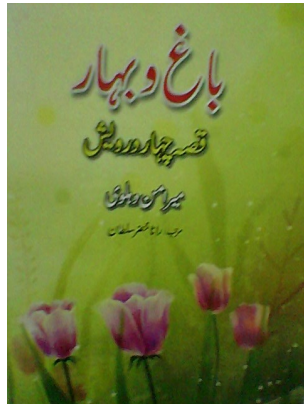
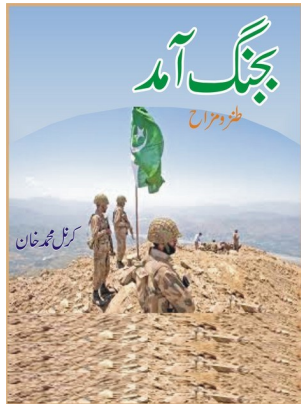
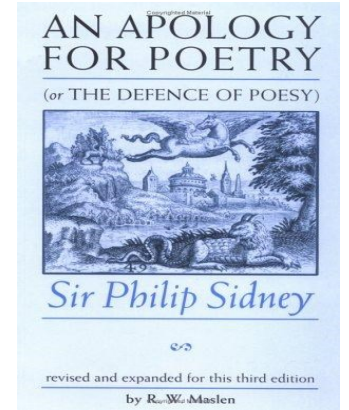
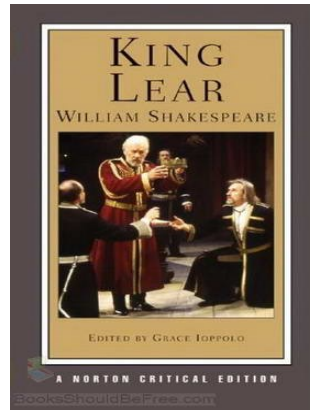
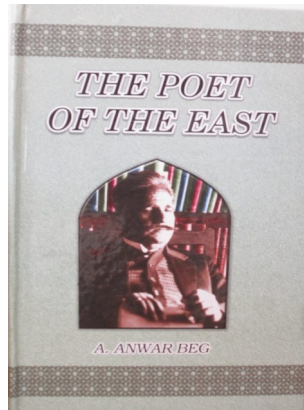
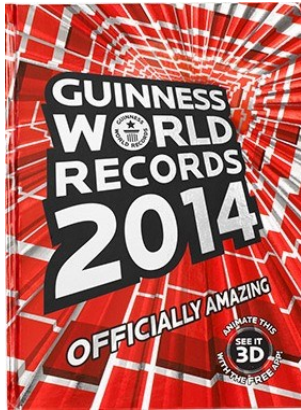
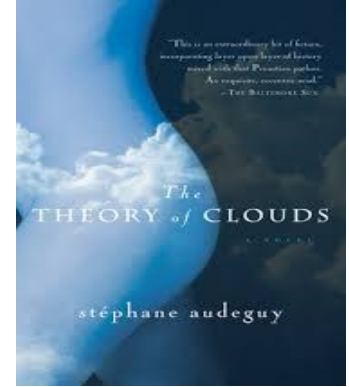
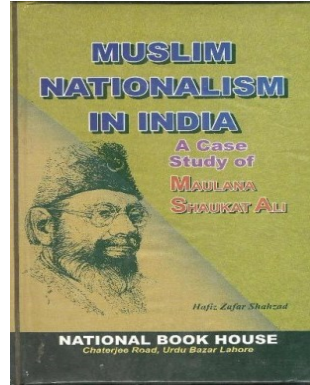
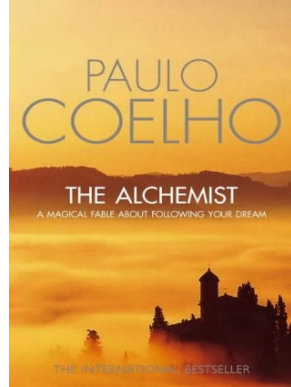
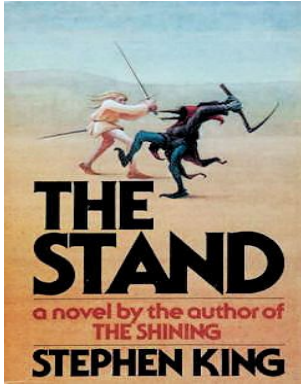


<b>NEAR</b> Retrieves items that have both terms in the same sentence. You can add a number to near to instruct the computer to find results within those numbers of words in any order	alcohol <b>near</b> abuse  alcohol <b>near3</b> abuse.	This will retrieve results where alcohol is within 3 words of abuse.  i.e., "Men who <i>abuse</i> their wives after alcohol consumption" or "Alcohol consumption leads to <i>abuse</i> "
<b>Nesting</b>  ( )	theater(actor <b>OR</b> actress)	Require the terms and operations that occur inside them to be searched first. This is called "nesting."
<b>Quotation marks</b>  “ ”	“working mothers”  ”affirmative action”	Requires words to search as a phrase, in the exact order you type them.
<b>Excluding Words</b>  -	dolphins -football  Jaguar speed -car	Add a dash (-) before a word or site to exclude all results that include that word. This is especially useful for words with multiple meanings, like Jaguar the car brand and jaguar the animal.
<b>Wildcard</b> *	“Obama voted * on *	Use * as a placeholder for unknown words in a phrase.
<b>Synonymous Terms</b> ~	~feminism	Use ~ immediately before a key term to search for synonyms.
<b>Stop words</b> +	“travel+with+theban”	use + to force a search for an important stop word
<b>#[word]</b>	[#privacy]	Using the ‘#’ before a word enables you to search for hash tags in Google+, Twitter, and more social networks.
<b>intitle:</b>	intitle:“Bob Marley”	Restricts a search to the titles of Web sites.
<b>inurl:</b>	inurl:butterflygardening	Restricts a search to the URL of a website
<b>filetype:</b>	intitle:“child nutrition” filetype:ppt	Searches for specific filename extensions. Googlesearches for PowerPoint (.ppt), Excel (.xls)and Word(.doc) documents as well as Adobe Acrobat (.pdf),Adobe Postscript (.ps), Rich Text Format(.rtf) and more
