As regards the organization of reading material, it has been done in the proper scientific manner. They have taken special care in assigning proper numbering and maintaining the record of books that have been donated to the place.

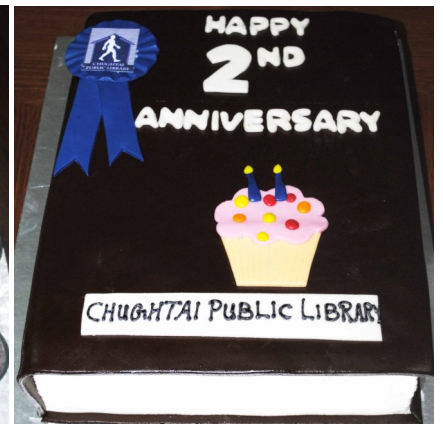
An interesting attraction for the users is the Free Service of coffee and tea at the place. There was a group of young men preparing for an exam.

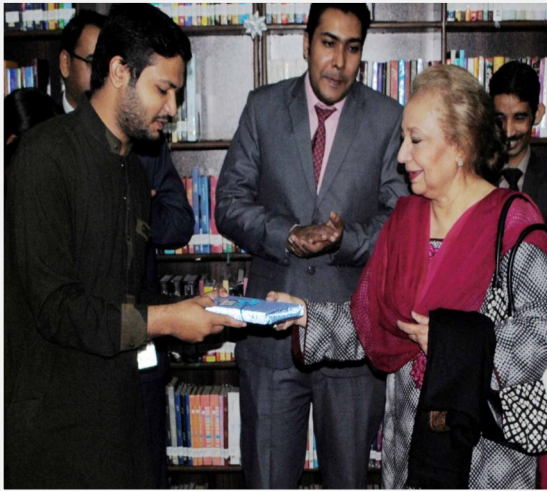
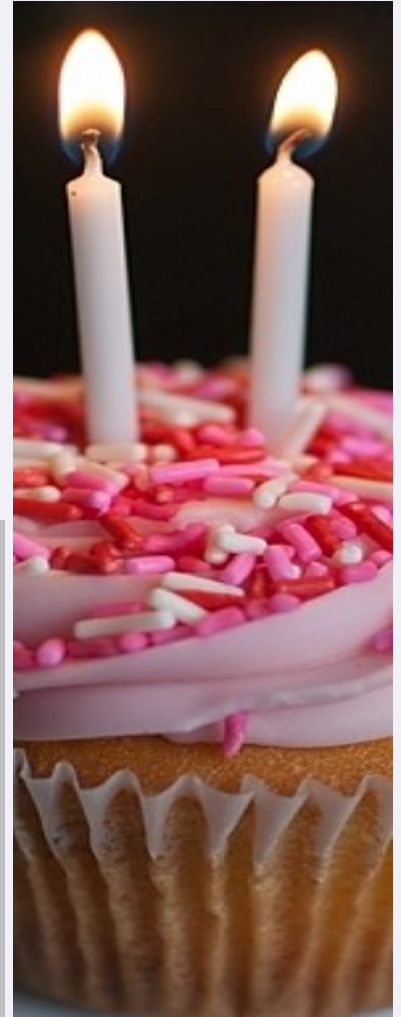

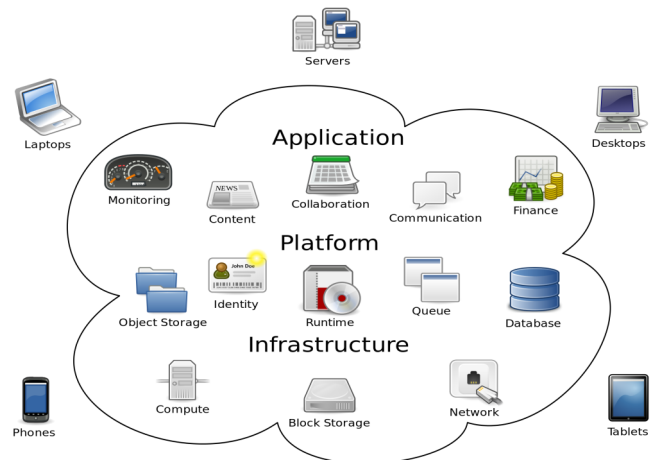
Dr. Danish Iqbal Donated Books to CPL:

- * rapid elasticity and measured service - services can be scaled larger or smaller;

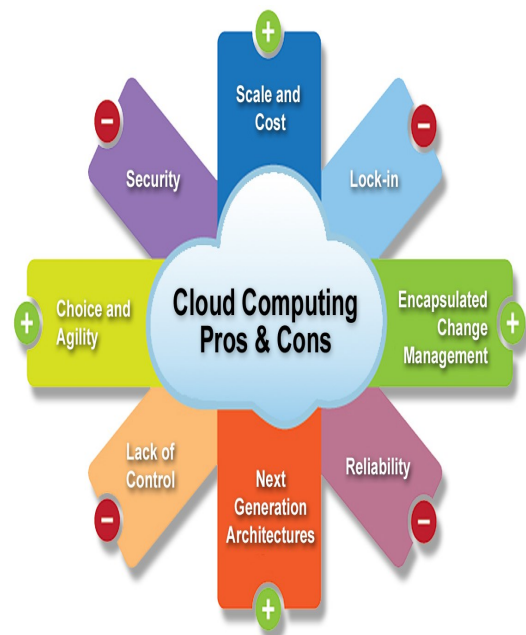
and use of a service is measured and customers are billed

- * resource pooling - customers draw from a pool of computing resources, usually in remote data centers

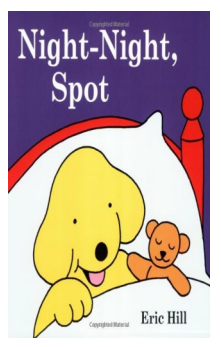
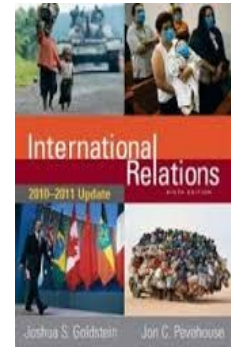
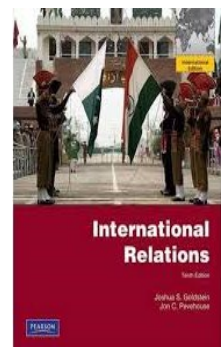
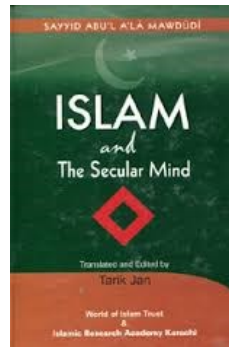
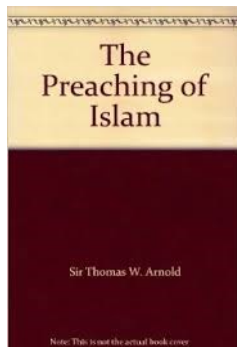
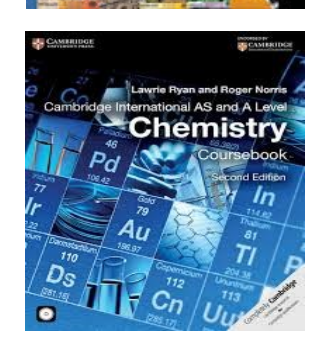
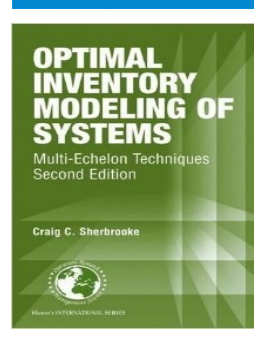
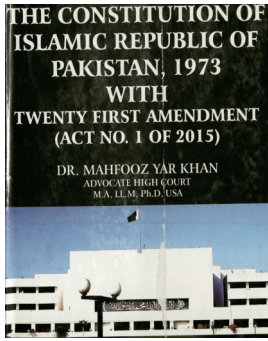
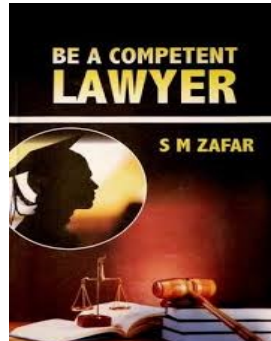
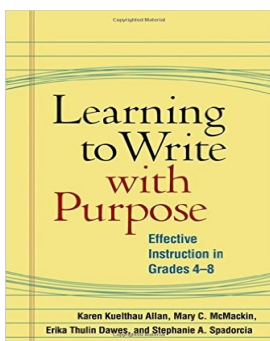
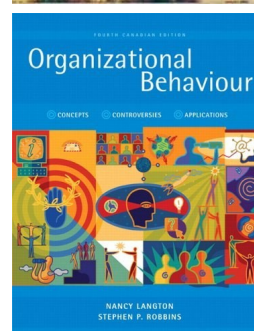
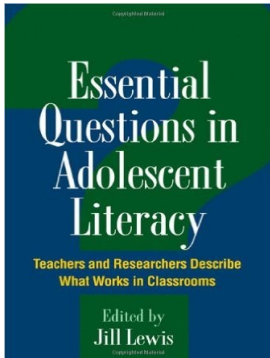
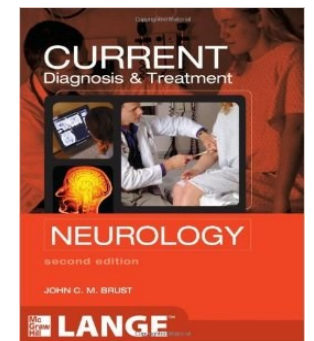
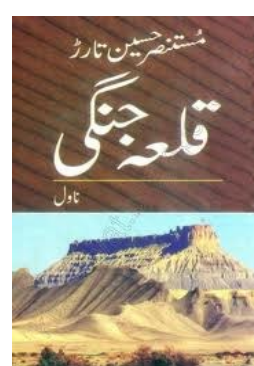
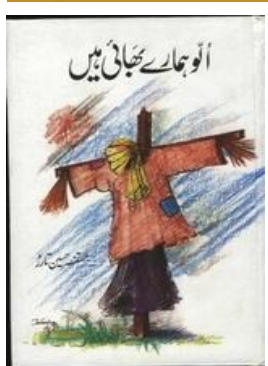
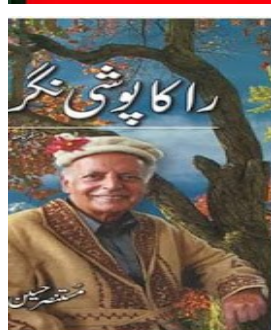
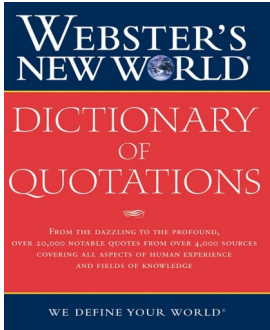
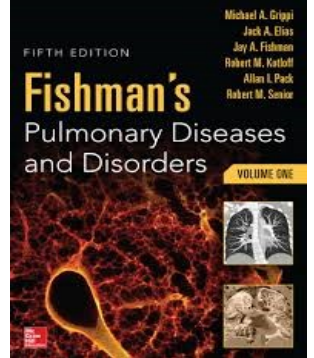
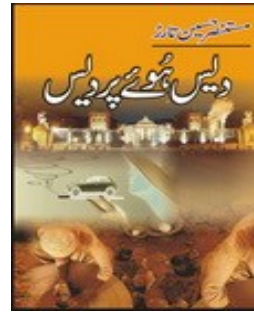
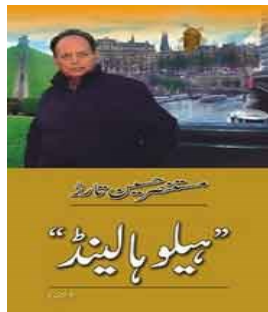
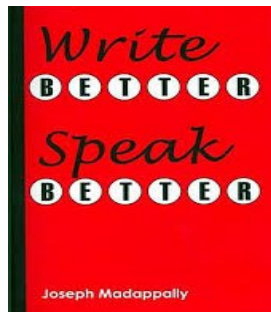
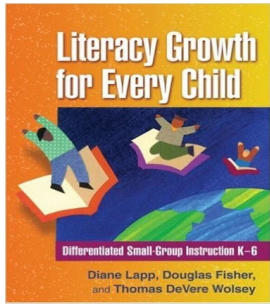
Benefits:

- * allows companies to avoid upfront infrastructure costs, and rather focus on projects that differentiate

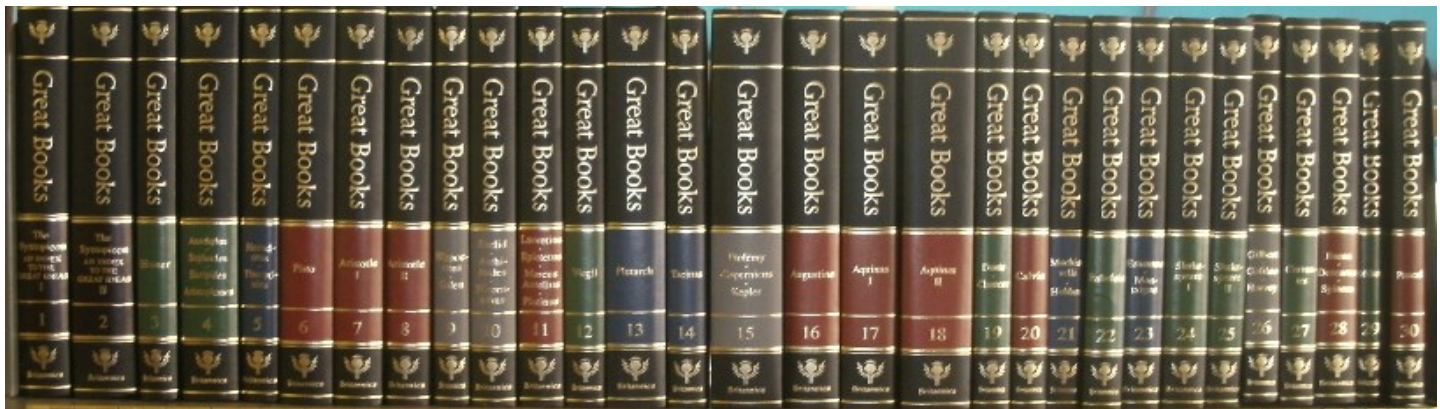
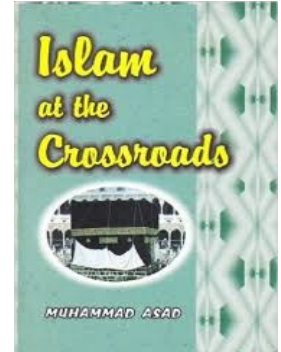
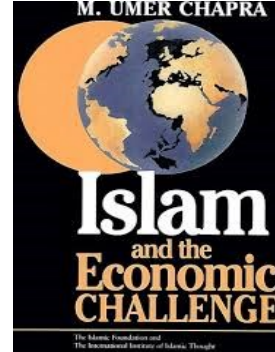
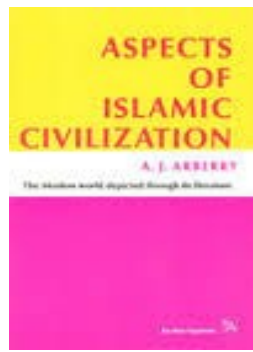
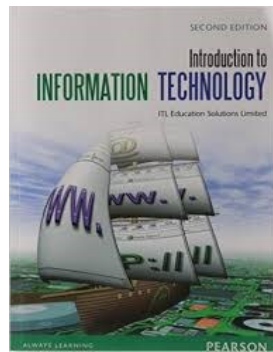
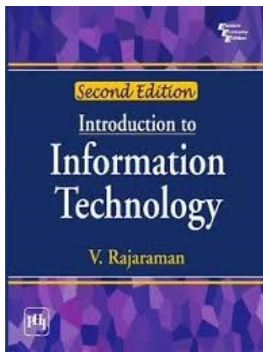
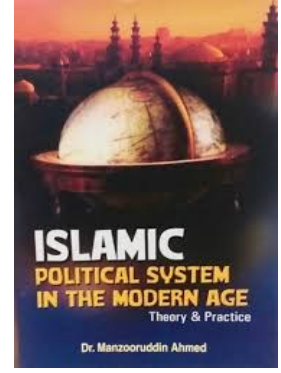
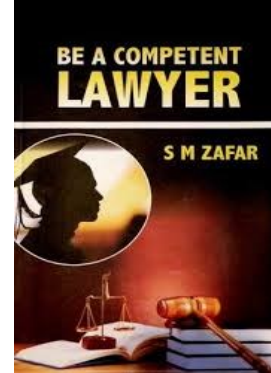
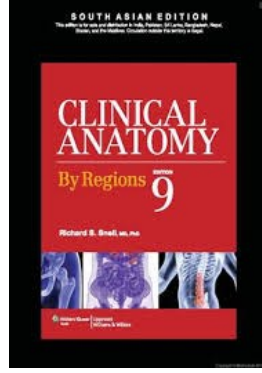
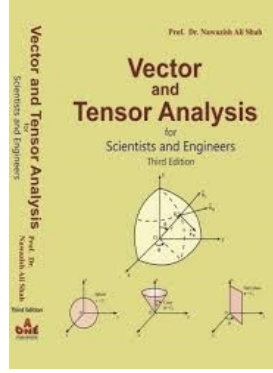
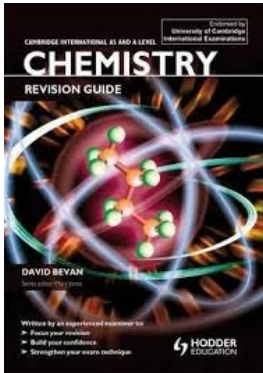
