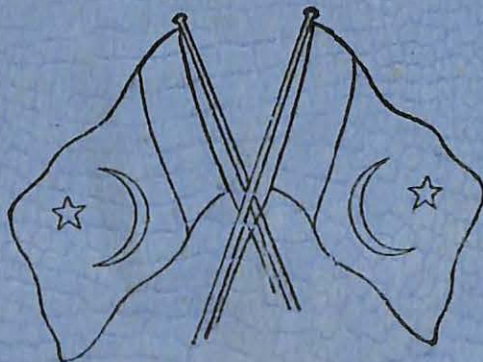

**Proceedings of the West Punjab Government in the Local Government
