Resolution-No. 146, Press, dated 22nd December 1941.

The Board submits its report on the settlement of land revenue in the Madras Presidency for fasli 1350 (1940-41) together with the prescribed statements.

The main features of the fasli are— are against to bloom the

- (i) The season was generally satisfactory—vide paragraph 2.
- (ii) The total extent of ryotwari holdings increased by 6,260 acres, from 27,605,309 acres (as now revised) in the previous fasli—vide paragraph 7.
 - (iii) The total assessment on holdings showed an increase of Rs. 42,630 from Rs. 6,03,00,577 (as now revised) the total assessment of the previous fasli—vide paragraph 8.
 - (iv) The total area cultivated in ryotwari holdings increased by 216,902 acres—vide paragraph 9.
- (v) The amount of water-rate and second crop charge increased by Rs. 8,10,572—vide paragraph 10.
 - (vi) Season remissions decreased by Rs. 16,15,300—vide paragraph 11 (i).
 - (vii) Fixed remissions increased by Rs. 1,889—vide paragraph 11 (ii).
 - (viii) Beriz deductions decreased by Rs. 1,37,611—vide paragraph 11 (iii).
 - (ix) The amount of revenue remitted in this fasli was Rs. 90·30 lakhs against Rs. 103·61 lakhs in the previous fasli—vide paragraph 11.
 - (x) Miscellaneous revenue increased by Rs. 4,24,797—vide paragraph 12.
 - (xi) There was a decrease in the number of land sales—vide paragraph 27.
- 2. Character of the season.—The South-West Monsoon set in early in the third week of May and caused fairly widespread rains up to the 22nd of the month and slackened thereafter. There was an advance of the Arabian Sea monsoon along the West Coast on the 4th June which was, however, not maintained. It again advanced into Malabar on the 14th June. The rainfall in June was below the normal in East Godavari (Agency), West Godavari, Kistna, Guntur, Bellary, Anantapur, Malabar and South Kanara, normal in Trichinopoly and above the normal elsewhere. The rainfall in July was, however, below the normal in all districts except East Godavari, West Godavari, Kistna, Ramnad and the West Coast where it was above the normal. In August, the monsoon was active between the 10th and 25th, being associated with two depressions in the Bay of Bengal off the Orissa-Circars coast on the 12th and the Orissa coast on the 21st. The heavy rains

Sowings of the late crops were above the average in the Carnatic and below the average in the Circars, the Deccan and in the central districts. The variations in the southern districts and the West Coast were small.

The condition of the late crops was generally satisfactory.

There were local thundershowers on the 1st, 2nd and 9th February. March was practically rainless and the Province was under a spell of unusually warm weather throughout the month. Salem, Coimbatore, Trichinopoly, the southern districts and Malabar experienced rainfall in April, mainly during the five days ending on the 15th. Malabar experienced a severe cyclone on the 26th May. The heavy rains received on the next two days worked considerable havoc in South Malabar, especially in Ponnani taluk. The rainfall in May was excessive in Malabar, above the normal in Vizagapatam, Salem, and Tinnevelly, normal in Chittoor and below the normal in the rest of the Province. On the whole the rainfall during the hot weather period (February to May 1941) was above the normal only in Salem, Coimbatore, Tanjore, Madura, Tinnevelly and Malabar and below the normal in the rest of the Province.

Generally, the season was favourable in the year under review in the Province, especially in Kurnool, Cuddapah, and Salem and was better than in the previous five years. This is corroborated by the fact that (i) the total area cropped, (ii) the area of crops sown more than once, (iii) the area irrigated, (iv) the area of crops irrigated, and (v) the estimated total yield of the main cereals (paddy, cholam, cumbu, ragi, korra, varagu, samai and maize) in the Province in 1940–41 were higher than in any of the previous five faslis. The area under paddy was the highest reported in any year. There were no relief operations under the Famine Code during the year under review.

Remissions of land revenue were appreciably less than in the previous year in most districts. Land revenue in the year under review had to be remitted on a comparatively large scale only in parts of East Godavari (Rs. 37,453), West Godavari (Rs. 89,737), Kistna (Rs. 96,635), Anantapur (Rs. 92,363), Chittoor (Rs. 55,118), North Arcot (Rs. 57,895) and Tanjore (Rs. 58,084). In view of the adverse seasonal conditions in 12 villages of the Bellary taluk, Government sanctioned the remission of dry assessment at four annas in the rupee but the amount involved in the remission was small, being only Rs. 4,142. In the Sankarankoil taluk of Tinnevelly the yield of cotton was affected by the heavy rains and consequently, the collection of four annas in the rupee of the March and May kists of the dry assessment of fasli 1349 was further postponed to fasli 1351.

In addition to the seasonal remissions and suspensions referred to above, Government ordered that the land revenue concessions granted for fasli 1349 on account of the fall in the prices of agricultural produce should be repeated for fasli 1350.

Stocks of fodder were generally sufficient.

- 3. The total number of ryotwari villages in the Presidency was 21,097 against 21,089 in the previous fasli. The increase of 8 villages was due to the following reasons:—
 - (i) Resumption of one mokhasa village in the Vizagapatam district.
 - (ii) Bifurcation of 2 villages in Gudur and Atmakur taluks of the Nellore district.
- (iii) Bifurcation of 3 villages in Proddatur, Siddhout and Rajampet taluks and resumption of one village in Rajampet taluk of the Cuddapah district.
- (iv) Bifurcation of 2 villages in Karur taluk of the Trichinopoly district.
 - (v) Decrease of one village in the Salem district due to regrouping of villages in the Hosur taluk.
- 4. The land revenue of the Province is derived from the following sources:—
 - (i) Peshkash or revenue from permanently settled estates;
 - (ii) shrotriyum jodi or quit-rent levited on inam villages;
- (iii) assessment including water-rate on lands held under ryotwari tenure; and
- (iv) miscellaneous revenue.
- 5. Peshkash or revenue from permanently settled estates.—
 The total amount of peshkash payable during the fasli was Rs. 47,46,042 as against Rs. 47,49,346 in the previous fasli. The decrease of Rs. 3,304 is explained below:—

in the Sankarankoil taluk of the Tinnevelly district was postponed to fasli 1351 under G.O. Ms. No. 429, Revenue, dated 26th February 1941.

- (b) Shavi and short crop.—The total amount remitted under this head was Rs. 2,05,571 against Rs. 11,36,541 in the previous fasli, the net decrease being Rs. 9,30,970. The decrease which was due to favourable seasonal conditions was marked in Kistna (Rs. 3,06,908), Tinnevelly (Rs. 1,18,295), Guntur (Rs. 1,16,749) and Chingleput (Rs. 99,853). There was, however, an increase in East Godavari (Rs. 7,863) and Chittoor (Rs. 398).
- (c) Tirvakammi remissions (i.e.), remissions of the difference between wet and dry assessments on wet lands cultivated with dry crops owing to insufficiency or failure of water-supply .-The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 1,79,068 against Rs. 5,21,271 in the previous fasli, resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 3,42,203. The decrease was marked in Tinnevelly (Rs. 94,497), Ramnad (Rs. 44,495) and Chingleput (Rs. 40,162).
- (d) Injury by floods. The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 78,323 against Rs. 1,67,273 in the previous fasli, resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 88,950.
- (e) Remission of second crop charge.—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 18,730 against Rs. 45,396 in the previous fasli, the net decrease being Rs. 26,666. The decrease was marked in North Arcot (Rs. 10,010).
- (ii) Fixed remissions (i.e., abatement of demand on account of reasons unconnected with the season).—These remissions amounted to Rs. 1.42 lakhs against Rs. 1.40 lakhs in the previous fasli, resulting in a net increase of Rs. 1,889. The increase was marked in East Godavari and South Arcot. In East Godavari, it was chiefly due to the introduction of new rates of assessment and in South Arcot to the alienations of land revenue sanctioned on a large scale for the lands purchased by the District Board for road purposes. - (iii) Beriz deductions.—Deductions made in favour of inamdars and religious institutions amounted to Rs. 8-19 lakhs against Rs. 9.57 lakhs in the previous fasli, resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 1,37,611.
- (iv) Special remissions.—In the Press Communiqué No. 95, dated 6th December 1940, the Government ordered that the land revenue concessions sanctioned for fasli 1347 and repeated in faslis 1348 and 1349 should be continued for fasli 1350 also. The concessions were in the following form :-
 - (1) Cancellation of percentage enhancement imposed at re-settlement on dry, wet and garden lands in certain tracts re-settled in recent years.
 - (2) Grant of a remission of two annas in the rupee of the wet assessment in the remaining areas of the Province.

(3) A temporary reduction of water-cess from Rs. 6-4-0 to Rs. 5-12-0 an acre for a first crop with corresponding reductions for other crops in the East and West Godavari and Kistna districts and in the deltaic tracts of the Guntur district.

The actual cost of the concessions granted under these orders came to Rs. 74·31 lakhs.

- 12. Miscellaneous Revenue.—The revenue under this head amounted to Rs. 121-89 lakhs against Rs. 117-64 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 6,91,005 in some districts and a decrease of Rs. 2,66,208 in others, resulting in a net increase of Rs. 4,24,797. The several items are dealt with below:—
 - Item 1. Jodi and quit-rent on minor inams.—The revenue under this head was Rs. 23-17 lakhs against Rs. 23-18 lakhs in the previous fasli, the net decrease being Rs. 960.
 - Item 2 (a). Second crop charge on minor inam wet lands in ryotwari villages.—The revenue under this head was Rs. 2.37 lakhs against Rs. 1.93 lakhs in the previous fasli, the net increase being Rs. 43,941.
 - (b) Water-rate on minor inams in ryotwari villages.—
 The revenue under this head was Rs. 17.78 lakhs against Rs. 16.93 lakhs in the previous fasli, resulting in a net increase of Rs. 85,723. The increase was marked in East Godavari (Rs. 47,892).
 - Item 3. Charge for water in villages in estates including tirvajasti and fasaljasti items.—The revenue under this head was Rs. 37.68 lakhs against Rs. 34.79 lakhs in the previous fasli, resulting in a net increase of Rs. 2,88,880. The increase was marked in Kistna (Rs. 1,17,545).
 - Item 4. Enhanced water-rate on lands irregularly irrigated.—The revenue under this head was Rs. 3.82 lakhs against Rs. 3.55 lakhs in the previous fasli, resulting in a net increase of Rs. 26,414.
 - Item 5. Charge levied for occupation (with or without permission) of assessed and unassessed lands not assigned.—
 The revenue under this head was Rs. 6.85 lakhs against Rs. 9.79 lakhs in the previous fasli, resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 2,93,559.
 - Item 6. Charges levied for occupation of poramboke lands.—
 The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 4.79 lakhs against Rs. 4.06 lakhs in the previous fasli, resulting in a net increase of Rs. 72,892. Enhanced charges amounting to Rs. 2,14,598, were levied on an extent of 27,798 acres against Rs. 1,93,721 on an extent of 29,789

acres in the previous fashi, showing an incidence of Rs. 8 per acre as against Rs. 7 per acre in the previous fasli. The highest district average rate was Rs. 26 in Coimbatore.

- There were no porambokes to be reclassified in the district of Madras. The work of reclassification is reported to have been completed in almost all the other districts. From the reports, it is, however, observed that taram assessment was levied on an extent of 71,394 acres against 67,448 acres in the previous fasli. Such occupation was extensive in Tanjore (10,261 acres), Guntur (9,677 acres), Bellary (7,694 acres), Anantapur (6,146 acres) and Salem (5,022
- Item 7. Revenue derived from taxed trees.-The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 3.55 lakhs against Rs. 3.49 lakhs in the previous fasli, the net increase being Rs. 5,776.
 - Item 8. Commission from estates under the Court of Wards.—The revenue derived from this source was Rs. 13 against Rs. 991 in the previous fasli, the net decrease being Rs. 978.
- Item 9. Revenue from process service fees.—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 0.04 lakh as in the previous fasli.
- Item 10. Sale proceeds of lands sold.—The income under this head was Rs. 0.75 lakh against Rs. 1.14 lakhs in the previous fasli, resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 38,362.
- Item 11. Rent of lankas.—The revenue under this head was Rs. 5.04 lakhs against Rs. 4.74 lakhs in the previous fasli, the net increase being Rs. 29.567.
- Item 12. Quit-rent and ground-rent.—The revenue under this head was Rs. 0.75 lakh against Rs. 1.14 lakhs in the previous fasli, the net increase being Rs. 27,261.

- 16. Demand and collection of land revenue and cesses (current).—The current demand under land revenue and cesses during the fasli was Rs. 9,37,03,632. A sum of Rs. 8,42,61,819 or 89.9 per cent was collected within the fasli and Rs. 70,61,847 or 7.5 per cent written off the accounts. The collection of a sum of Rs. 6,16,654 or 0.7 per cent was suspended or postponed. The percentage of collection to collectable demand was therefore 98.0. The percentage of collection to demand during the previous fasli was 90.0, that written off was 7.6 and that suspended or postponed 0.8. The percentage of collection to the collectable demand was 98.4. The land revenue concessions for fasli 1350 have been dealt with in paragraph 11 (iv) above.
- 17. The demand and collection of arrears.—The total arrear demand under all the heads amounted to Rs. 28,92,301. A sum of Rs. 18,32,458 or 63.4 per cent was collected and a sum of Rs. 36,322 or 1.3 per cent written off the accounts. The percentage of collection in the previous fashi was 78.7 and that written off was 3.0.
- 18. The balance outstanding at the end of the fasli including both arrears and current was Rs. 34,03,485 against Rs. 28,90,288

at the end of the previous fasli. As reported by the Collectors in their Demand, Collection and Balance statements for October 1941 the balance at the beginning of fasli 1351 was Rs. 34,11,388. Up to the end of October 1941 a sum of Rs. 19,54,581 was collected and Rs. 39,694 written off the accounts. Sanction has been accorded to write off Rs. 25 and proposals have been made to write off Rs. 97,605. The net recoverable balance on 1st November 1941 was thus Rs. 13,19,483. Out of this amount a sum of Rs. 7,12,987 is covered by orders of suspension or post-ponements in the Presidency. Deducting this amount, the realizable balance on 1st November 1941 was Rs. 6,06,496.

19. Adjustments to Local Boards of cesses collected during the fasti.—Land revenue and cesses are collected together and the distribution of the total collections between land revenue and cesses is effected in the Collector's office after the compilation of the accounts relating to the fasli year.

Statements showing the amounts collected during fasli 1350 on behalf of Local Boards, the payments made to them during the fasli and the amounts to be finally adjusted either to their credit or debit are received from the Collectors. After verification, by the Accountant-General, of the amounts shown by Collectors as payments made to Local Boards, the recovery of overpayments is being watched by the Board in accordance with the instructions contained in paragraph (3) of G.O. No. 5197, L. & M., dated 7th December 1926.

20. Charges debitable to land revenue.—The charges in the Land Revenue department are shown in the accounts under the head '25. General Administration'. The District Administration charges excluding village establishments amounted to Rs. 106·21 lakhs during fasli 1350. The village service charges including those of proprietary estates during the fasli were Rs. 116·30 lakhs. The total charges amounted to Rs. 222·51 lakhs or 25·8 per cent of the total land revenue and cesses collected.

It has, however, to be borne in mind that the expenditure does not represent merely the cost of collecting the land revenue. The Land Revenue department performs multifarious duties, of which the control and collection of land revenue is only one. The village establishment in particular is the servant of all departments of the Government. Moreover a considerable portion of the time of the Collector and his subordinate officials is occupied with magisterial work. While the actual cost of collecting the land revenue cannot be estimated with any degree of accuracy, it is certainly far less than the amount of expenditure shown above.

21. Process under Act II of 1864.—Statement No. 12 gives particulars of coercive processes issued for the realization of the Government dues under Madras Act II of 1864. The following

extract shows the number of processes issued during the fasli under report as compared with those for the three preceding faslis :-

There is an increase in the number of demand notices and decrease in the number of distraint or attachment notices and also of sale notices and the number of defaulters whose properties (personal and real) were sold shows a decrease of nearly 22 per cent as compared with fasli 1349.

- 22. Demand notices.—The number of demand notices issued during the fash is less than those of fashis 1347 and 1348 and more than those of fasli 1349.
- 23. Distraint or attachment notices.—There is an appreciable decrease in the number of distraint or attachment notices when compared with those of the three previous faslis 1347, 1348 and 1349.
- 24. There is a decrease of 2.22 in the percentage of the number of notices of distraint and attachment of personal property to the total number of demand notices when compared with the previous fasli. There is also a decrease of 0.62 per cent in respect of real

The number of defaulters whose immovable properties were attached during the fasli was 21,866 against 28,406 in fasli 1349.

- 25. Sale notices. -Out of 93,768 defaulters whose properties were attached, 34.96 per cent paid up the arrears before sale notices were issued as against 31-13 per cent in the last fasli. The number of notices of sale was large in Tanjore (15,300) and Malabar (17,703).
- 26. Sales.—The number of defaulters whose properties were sold in the fasli was less than the number in fasli 1349 by 2,872. There was a decrease in the number of sales of personal property by 1,987 and a decrease in the number of sales of real property by 885. The percentage borne by the actual number of sales to the number of sale notices in the province is 16.22 against 14.98 in

fasli 1349. The percentage of the number of defaulters whose properties were sold, to the total number of holdings, is 0·15 against 0·21 in the previous fasli. The statement below shows the particulars of sales in fasli 1350 as compared with those for the previous three faslis:—

Value of lands sold.—Immovable property of the estimated value of Rs. 4,40,023 was sold for the recovery of arrears amounting to Rs. 1,36,952. The amount realized was Rs. 1,32,182. The estimated value of lands sold was noticeably disproportionate to the arrears in most of the districts. The prices fetched for lands sold to private individuals amounted on the average to eight and a half times the assessment in the case of dry lands and ten and one-fifth times the assessment in the case of wet lands. In fasli 1349 immovable property of the estimated value of Rs. 4,02,139 was sold for the recovery of arrears amounting to Rs. 1,91,169 and the amount realized was Rs. 1,26,482. The average price fetched for lands sold to private individuals is greater than in fasli 1349 in the case of dry lands, being eight and half times the assessment against three and one-fifteenth times in fasli 1349 and it is equal in the case of wet lands.

Extent of lands sold.—The extent of lands sold to private individuals in the fasli was 3,323 acres under dry and 1,202 acres under wet against 9,256 and 2,587 acres respectively in fasli 1349. The total area bought in by the Government for want of bidders was 6,529 acres under dry and 2,798 acres under wet against 6,485 and 3,955 acres respectively in fasli 1349. The total area of lands sold is 13,852 acres against the total holdings of 27,611,569 acres or one acre in every 1,993 acres.

27. Process service establishment.—Statement No. 13 gives the particulars of processes served by the ordinary village agency and by the special establishment and of the fees realized during the fasli. The total number of processes served by the village agency was 1,257,122 or 5,411 more than in fasli 1349. The number of processes served by the special agency (22,985) was less than in the previous fasli by 184.

28. Costs in civil suits .- A sum of Rs. 16,980 was awarded to the Government as costs during the fasli. Including the revised opening balance, the total demand was Rs. 55,280 of which Rs. 16,720 was collected and Rs. 1,081 written off the accounts. 29. Interest on arrears of land revenue—Statement No. 14.—The total demand on account of interest on arrears of land revenue including the balance at the beginning of the fasli was Rs. 2,04,320 of which Rs. 21,062 was collected and Rs. 905 was remitted leaving a balance of Rs. 1,82,353. The balance exceeds Rs. 1,000 in Vizagapatam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Kistna, Nellore, Chingleput, Chittoor, South Arcot, Tanjore, Ramnad and Tinnevelly, and about the to anomapileus to redmun latet sall

30. Sale of lands under Board's Standing Orders Nos. 15, 16, 21, 22, 45, 90, 91 and 197.—1,986·14 acres of lands assessed at Rs. 3.187-2-0 were sold for Rs. 86,517-7-0 under Standing Order No. 15; 37.46 acres of house-sites with a ground-rent of Rs. 346-13-0 were sold for Rs. 39,904-14-0 under Standing Order No. 21; 5.29 acres of lands occupied by the Government departments were sold for Rs. 3,914-8-0 under Standing Order No. 22; 1.270.57 acres of lands bought in by the Government at sales for arrears of land revenue were re-sold under Standing Order No. 45 for Rs. 2,904-10-0; 100.93 acres of lands which had been acquired for public purposes but subsequently relinquished were sold under Standing Order No. 90 for 9,907-7-0; 33.06 acres of lands for which the railways were not likely to have any further use were sold for Rs. 4,432-12-0 under Standing Order No. 91. Lastly an extent of o caw. 9 gr. 67 sq. ft. of land was sold in Madras City for Rs. 222-15-0 subject to the payment of an annual ground-rent of Rs. 204-1-0 under the special rules governing the disposal of waste lands in the city contained in Appendix XXII to Standing Order No. 21. There have been no sales of either escheated or tank-bed lands during the year under report.

31. Subdivision of quit-rent.—In the fasli there was one case under Standing Order No. 58 of the subdivision of joint liability of shareholders in enfranchised in the subdivision of joint liability of shareholders in enfranchised inams.

- 32. Transfer of revenue registry.—Transfer of registry falls under the following main heads:—
- (i) Transfer made with reference to applications and notices received from Sub-Registrars.
 - (ii) Transfer effected on applications and intimations received from parties, village officers and others.

(ii) Under the second head the number received was 213,482 against 269,522 in the previous fasli, the net decrease being 56,040 or about 20.8 per cent.

There was a general decrease in all districts. There was an increase in Bellary (853) and South Arcot (1,694).

The total number of applications of all kinds including the number pending disposal at the beginning of the fashi was 735,820, of which 661,259 were disposed of during the fashi leaving a balance of 74,561 (or about 10·1 per cent of the total number) as against 72,054 or about 9·5 per cent of the total number in the previous fashi. Of the total number of applications disposed of during the fashi 30,591 (or about 4·6 per cent) were rejected and 2,281 were transferred to Deputy Tahsildars for disposal. The causes of rejection were mainly defective title and failure of the parties to produce documentary evidence. The percentage of pendency was marked in Vizagapatam (30), East Godavari (27) and Anantapur (21).

- 33. The rule laid down in paragraph 2 of Board's Standing Order No. 12, that generally the Collector should himself conduct the settlement of each taluk once in five years, was complied with in all the districts except in the case of Papanasam and Pattukkottai taluks in Tanjore district and Musiri taluk in Trichinopoly district. The Collector of Tanjore was permitted in February 1935 to arrange the cycle of the Collector's jamabandi of the district so as to cover a period of six years. The Collector of Trichinopoly was permitted to conduct the jamabandi of Musiri taluk in 1942.
- 34. The advances made under the Land Improvement Loans and Agriculturists' Loans Acts during the year amounted to Rs. 5.93

lakhs against Rs. 14·49 lakhs in the previous year. The amount advanced during the year under the Agriculturists' Loans (Madras Amendment) Act, 1935, for the relief of agricultural indebtedness was Rs. 1·22 lakhs.

35. Including the uncollected balance at the end of the previous year, the amount repayable during the year on account of principal under both the Land Improvement Loans and Agriculturists' Loans Acts was Rs. 17.68 lakhs against Rs. 16.85 lakhs in the preceding year. Of this amount a sum of Rs. 12.53 lakhs or 71 per cent was collected. A sum of Rs. 1.26 lakhs was repaid by the borrowers on account of loans the repayment of which had not fallen due, while a sum of Rs. 5,047 was written off as irrecoverable.

The amount repayable during the year under the Agriculturists' Loans (Madras Amendment) Act, 1935, was Rs. 1,62,230 of which Rs. 1,44,371 was collected.

36. The aggregate amount of principal and interest repayable during the year under the Land Improvement Loans and Agriculturists' Loans Acts, including the balance remaining unpaid out of sums which fell due in the previous years was Rs. 23,42,616 of which a sum of Rs. 17,40,134 or 74 per cent was collected and a sum of Rs. 6,087 was written off. The balance outstanding at the end of the year was Rs. 5,96,395 against Rs. 5,21,328 in the previous year.

The aggregate amount of principal and interest repayable during the year under the Agriculturists' Loans (Madras Amendment) Act, 1935, was Rs. 2,54,702 of which a sum of Rs. 2,31,183 was collected during the year. The balance outstanding at the end of the year was Rs. 23,519.

37. The advances drawn by Collectors during the official year 1940-41 under the head "Revenue Survey Advances—Collectors" amounted to Rs. 88,503 as detailed below against Rs. 99,216 in the previous year:—

Of the total amount of advances outstanding against Collectors including the amounts referred to above, a sum of Rs. 92,286 was adjusted during the year, leaving a net debit balance of Rs. 2,32,157.

Under the head "cost of survey marks—Collectors," a sum of Rs. 75,815 was collected during the year, leaving a balance of Rs. 11,934 to be realized.

The arrears at the beginning of the year under "cost of survey marks—Survey officers" was Rs. 62,060 (as now revised). Fresh landholders' bills for Rs. 25,123 were received from survey officers during the year. Of the total demand of Rs. 87,183 a sum of Rs. 37,525 was collected, leaving a balance of Rs. 49,658. A large portion of the amount is outstanding in East Godavari (Rs. 15,008), Coimbatore (Rs. 8,382), Malabar (Rs. 7,612) and Madras (Rs. 6,511).

38. The scheme for the grant of loans for the relief of indebtedness under the Agriculturists' Loans (Madras Amendment) Act, 1935, was in force during the year in all the districts of the Presidency except Madras.

All the 92 Debt Conciliation Boards continued to work throughout the year.

- 39. Enhanced water-cess on irregular irrigation.—The system of publishing a general or collective notice in each village in accordance with B.P. No. 58, Settlement, dated 10th April 1919, is reported to have worked well. The ryots were aware of the rules and made timely representations to the jamabandi officers. The system resulted in the prompt investigation of objections, and consequent reduction in the number of water-rate appeals. In cases where Government water was taken without permission, deterrent penalties were imposed.
- 40. Cultivation of tank-bed lands.—In some districts tank-bed lands were cultivated with cucumber or melons. Whenever the cultivation was permitted, ordinary dry rates were charged, and cases of objectionable cultivation were dealt with under the provisions of the Madras Land Encroachment Act.
- 41. Cowle.—During the fasli 270 acres of land were held on cowle for Rs. 116 against 270 acres on Rs. 115 in the previous fasli.
- 42. Examination of village and taluk accounts.—The maintenance of these registers was fairly satisfactory and no general errors of a serious nature were disclosed. Certain minor defects noticed were duly rectified.
- 43. The Taluk and Village Statistical Registers.—The taluk statistical registers prescribed in the Manual of Taluk Accounts (Special) were maintained in the districts of Malabar, South Kanara and the Nilgiris.

The village statistical registers were maintained in almost all the ryotwari villages of the other districts. The following statement shows the progress made in the writing up and checking of these registers up to and during the fasli 1350:—

- 44. Minor irrigation.—Statement No. 19 shows for each district the number of works in charge of the Revenue department, the number repaired and the amount spent on them during the official year ending 31st March 1941. The statement also shows the number proposed for repair during the official year ending 31st March 1942.
- 45. Conference with ryots.—Ryots' conferences were held in all the districts except Chingleput, Chittoor, Coimbatore and Malabar, and the grievances of the ryots were either redressed or steps were taken to redress them.
- 46. Extent to which the inspection of subordinate offices has been carried out by the Board, Collectors and Revenue Divisional Officers.—All subordinate offices were inspected by the Collectors and the Revenue Divisional Officers. The Collectors' inspection of the Revenue Divisional offices was generally thorough. The

Board examined the notes of inspection and issued suitable instructions.

During the fasli under report, the Members of the Board of Revenue inspected the offices of the Collectors of Chittoor, Chingleput, Cuddapah, North Arcot, Trichinopoly, Ramnad, Coimbatore, Kistna, Guntur, West Godavari, Salem, Madura and Tanjore and found that the administration of the districts continued to be efficient.

47. Administration of charitable and religious service inams.—
The administration of charitable and religious service inams continued to be generally satisfactory in all districts.

In cases of alienation of the inam lands or cessation of the prescribed services every facility was afforded to the inamdars to redeem the inams alienated by them or to revive the service. The inams were resumed only on the failure of the inamdars to avail themselves of the opportunity afforded to them. The principles laid down in paragraphs 7 and 8 of Board's Standing Order No. 54 were duly observed in connexion with the reassignment of the net assessment on the resumed inams. 2,890.53 acres of religious and 62:12 acres of charitable service inams with an assessment of Rs. 2,168-7-4 and Rs. 227-3-0 respectively were resumed in the fasli on account of alienation of the inam lands or cessation of the prescribed services or disappearance of the institutions. As regards resumed religious service inams net assessments amounting to Rs. 2,081-2-8 were reassigned to working incumbents and the balance of Rs. 87-4-8 was credited to the general revenues. In respect of resumed charitatble service inams net assessments amounting to Rs. 125-11-5 were reassigned to the working incumbents and the balance of Rs. 101-7-7 was credited to the general revenues.

48. Rent roll (Quinquennial).—Statement No. 20 shows the number of pattas of various values held in the several districts of the Presidency for fasli 1350 (1940-41). Excluding Madras, where the land revenue consists mainly of quit-rent imposed on house-sites, the total number of pattas held during the last fasli of the quinquennium was 6,689,824, or 520,242 more than at the end of the previous quinquennium, i.e., 65,843 under single pattas and 454,399 under joint pattas. There was an increase in all the districts except Anantapur and Ramnad. In Anantapur there was a decrease of 5,750 pattas and in Ramnad the decrease was 3,234. The increase was marked in Malabar (148,324), Guntur (71,187), Nellore (67,598), South Arcot (28,969), Tanjore (24,250) and North Arcot (23,474). These districts contributed an increase of 363,802, or about 70 per cent of the total increase. The increase was mainly due to the grant of waste lands on darkhast, and to the splitting up of joint holdings, and the grant of separate pattas

after subdivision to the several joint-holders. The bulk of the increase under single and joint pattas was confined to pattas paying Rs. 10 and less but over Re. 1. This came to 241,317 or about 46 per cent of the total increase. Of the total number of pattas held, 3,652,536 or about 54 per cent, were assessed at Rs. 10 and less but over Re. 1 a year, the gross assessment thereon being Rs. 1,52,49,503. The average extent of land and assessment on pattas paying Rs. 10 and less but over Re. 1, work out to about 3 acres and Rs. 4 respectively. The bulk of the land covered by these small holdings is dry (9,399,485 acres).
