SEASON AND CROP REPORT OF THE PROVINCE OF BOMBAY FOR THE YEAR 1942-43.

CHAPTER I—CHARACTER OF THE SEASON.

In general, the agricultural season of 1942-43 was favourable, so far as the *kharif* season was concerned, over the greater part of the Province. The *rabi* season, however, was definitely unfavourable in large areas and resulted in the occurrence of famine and scarcity conditions in several districts of the Central and Southern Divisions, notably in the Bijapur and Sholapur districts and in parts of the Belgaum, Dharwar and Satara districts. The year under report was characterised by heavy precipitations of rain in the early monsoon season and by the early cessation of the monsoon rains and the almost complete absence of late rains especially in those districts which depend upon late rainfall for the bulk of their crop production which takes place in the *rabi* season. The monsoon broke about mid-June and rainfall was heavy up to mid-August except in the south-eastern districts where only light and irregular showers provided inadequate soil moisture for cultural operations and for satisfactory crop germination. In the Konkan and in the southern areas of Gujarat, the early monsoon rains were excessive and caused delay in *kharif* cultivation and damage to sown crops necessitating re-sowing in some areas. Elsewhere in the Province, the general outlook for the *kharif* season was satisfactory and the favourable nature of the early monsoon was reflected in the increased area and outturn of food crops. The activity of the monsoon declined towards the end of August and there was practically no rainfall after mid-September except for a few scattered showers in the south of the Province in late December. This complete failure of the late monsoon not only resulted in the decrease in the outturn of *kharif* crops in many tracts but affected most adversely the prospects of *rabi* crop cultivation particularly in the eastern parts of the South Deccan and the Karnatak. In these areas, which had experienced scarcity condition in the previous year, the *rabi* crops failed over wide tracts and a serious shortage of food and fodder developed and famine conditions prevailed over the south eastern parts of the Karnatak e.g., in the Bijapur district and parts of the Sholapur, Belgaum and Dharwar districts in particular. In the worst affected areas, relief measures had to be started by Government and non-official organizations. The adverse *rabi* season resulted in a considerable drop in the acreage under *rabi* crops and, except in Gujarat and the more favoured areas of the Deccan, the *rabi* crop outturns were much below normal.

2. *Distribution of rainfall.*—Table 1 (pages 16-17) compares the rainfall during the year under review with the average annual fall of rain at each representative recording station in the Province. The average rainfall figures for each station have been supplied by the India Meteorological Department.

Kharif Rains.—The *kharif* rains exceeded the average everywhere in the Province except at Nasik and Sholapur in the Deccan and at Bijapur and Dharwar in the Karnatak where they were below normal.

Rabi Rains.—The *rabi* rains during the year under report were entirely absent in Gujarat and at Thana in the Konkan. Elsewhere in the Province these rains were below normal except at Dhulia (West Khandesh) and Nagar (Ahmednagar) in the Deccan and at Bijapur in the Karnatak where they somewhat exceeded the usual amount.

Hot Weather Rains.—This year these rains fell much in excess of the average everywhere in the Province, some stations recording more than three to four times the normal amount.

CHAPTER II—AREA CULTIVATED AND UNCULTIVATED.

(Table II, pages 18-20.)

3. *Number of Villages.*—The total number of villages in the Province decreased by seventy from 22,845 in 1941-42 to 22,775 during the year under report due to amalgamation with adjoining villages of 60 villages in East Khandesh, of 1 village each in the West Khandesh and Nasik districts in the Deccan and of 8 villages in the Bijapur district in the Karnatak for administrative convenience.

4. *Total area and Reporting and Non-reporting area.*—The total and reporting areas expanded by 12,680 and 229,489 acres respectively, the increase in the former being noticeable mainly in Gujarat and the Karnatak and in the latter in the Deccan and Karnatak. The variations under non-reporting area generally correspond with those under reporting area.

5. *Cropped Areas.*—The gross and net cropped areas decreased by 2·3 per cent. and 2·7 per cent. respectively as compared with the previous year, the decrease being marked in the Deccan and Karnatak. The twice cropped area, on the other hand, showed an increase of 10·0 per cent. which was shared by all the Divisions in the Province except the Deccan. The assessed and unassessed areas remained almost the same as last year.

An area of about 116,000 acres of forest land was given out for temporary cultivation, of which 91,000 acres were in the Deccan, 21,000 acres in the Konkan and 4,000 acres in Gujarat. About 109,000 acres of culturable waste or "Other uncultivated land excluding current fallows" in Deccan (59,000 acres), in Gujarat (31,000 acres), in Konkan (15,000 acres) and in Karnatak (4,000 acres) were also utilised in a similar way.

CHAPTERS III AND IV—CROPPED AND IRRIGATED AREAS.

(Tables III and IV, pages 21-31.)

(Table IV-A, page 32.)

6. *Total Areas under Crops and Irrigation.*—The total area under crops showed a reduction of 690,000 acres or by 2·3 per cent. during the year under report, the decrease being shared by Deccan and Karnatak. The total area under irrigation remained almost stationary as compared with the previous year.

7. *Food Crops.*—(a) *Total Area.*—Among the main food crops the total area under rice showed a general increase of 198,000 acres or by 10·3 per cent. as compared with that of the previous year. In the case of wheat the total area went down by 234,000 acres or by 15·0 per cent. mainly in the Deccan (123,000 acres) and the Karnatak (192,000 acres) due to inadequate late rains. Against this, there was an increase in Gujarat (81,000 acres). The area under *jowar* decreased by 1,039,000 acres or by 12·3 per cent. during the year under report, it being shared by the Deccan (892,000 acres) and Karnatak (199,000 acres). Under *bajri* the total area showed a general advancement of 1,461,000 acres or by 38·2 per cent. The area under gram decreased by 92,000 acres or by 17·8 per cent. as compared with the previous year, the decrease being noticeable mostly in the Deccan (113,000 acres).

(b) *Irrigated Area.*—The irrigated areas under rice and wheat showed a general expansion of 22,000 acres or by 10·6 per cent. and 32,000 acres or by 21·0 per cent. respectively over those of the previous year. In the case of *jowar*, this area decreased

by 6,000 acres or by 2·1 per cent. the decrease being mostly in the Deccan, while that under *bajri* showed a general advancement of 10,000 acres or by 14·3 per cent. Under Sugarcane the area which is mostly irrigated showed a general decline of 7,000 acres or by 6·3 per cent. during the year under report. The area under fruits and vegetables showed a small increase of 1,700 acres or by 0·8 per cent. the increase being shared by all the divisions except Deccan.

8. *Non-Food Crops*.—The total and irrigated areas under cotton showed a general decline of 1,204,000 acres or by 29·8 per cent. and of 24,000 acres or by 64·9 per cent. respectively as compared with the previous year due mainly to the propaganda carried under "Grow More Food Crops" Campaign by the Agricultural Department. The tobacco acreage also decreased by 82,000 acres or by 39·0 per cent. during the year under report, the decrease being shared by all the Divisions in the Province. The total area under oil-seeds showed a reduction of 203,000 acres or by 8·9 per cent. as compared with the previous year, mainly in the Deccan (—209,000 acres). Among oil-seeds the area under groundnut showed a curtailment of 45,000 acres or by 3·5 per cent. while that under sesamum an advancement of 43,000 acres or by 28·2 per cent. during the year under report.

9. *Kharif and Rabi Areas*.—The following table compares the areas under *kharif* and *rabi* crops during the year under report with those of the preceding two years:—

It will be seen from the above table that the *kharif* area during the year under report showed an expansion over that of last year (1941-42) as well as of 1940-41. The *rabi* area, on the other hand, contracted as compared with the previous year (1941-42) and also the year 1940-41. The net result of these variations was that the total area under cereals and pulses increased by 773,000 acres or by 3·8 per cent. over the area under these crops during last year (1941-42) and by 461,000 acres or by 2·2 per cent. over the year (1940-41).

10. *Area irrigated from different Sources of Irrigation*.—The area irrigated by Government Canals decreased by 2,000 acres or by 0·7 per cent. as compared with the previous year, the decrease being mainly noticeable in the Karnatak. Irrigation by Private Canals, on the other hand showed a general increase of 3,000 acres or by 5·4 per cent. Well irrigation declined by 48,000 acres or by 7·1 per cent. during the year under report, the decrease being shared by all the Divisions except Konkan.

The area irrigated by Tanks showed a general increase of 42,000 acres or 37·2 per cent. while that irrigated from Other Sources of irrigation also increased by 6,000 acres or by 28·6 per cent. as compared with the previous year, the increase being noticeable in all the Divisions except Gujarat.

The ratio of irrigated area to the net cropped area was 4·2 per cent. during the year under report.

11. *Number of Irrigation Sources.*—The year 1942-43 is that in which the decennial enumeration of the sources of water supply in the Bombay Province is made and following is the summary of the results:—

The details will be found in Appendix D (i) (page 15). The number of Government Canals for irrigation both *pakka* and *kachha* (i.e., masonry and non-masonry) taken together showed a small rise of 32 while in the case of Private Canals for irrigation both masonry and non-masonry taken together it showed a slight fall of 12 during the last decennium. The number of wells for irrigation (masonry and non-masonry combined) showed a rise of 36,249 during the last quinquennium (as in the case of irrigation wells the enumeration is done once in five years and the last one was accordingly made in 1937-38). The increase was general and was mainly due to construction of new wells. Similarly, the number of wells for drinking purposes (masonry and non-masonry taken together) rose by 20,327 since the last decennial enumeration in 1932-33, the increase being noticeable in all Divisions of the Province due to the same cause which brought rise in the number of wells for irrigation. Under tanks (both masonry and non-masonry combined) those utilised for irrigation purposes showed an increase of 783 due mainly to construction of new tanks. The number of tanks for other purposes (masonry and non-masonry taken together) showed an increase of 15 as compared with the previous enumeration.

CHAPTER V—OUTTURN OF CROPS.

(Tables V pages 38-39 and V-A pages 40-53.)

12. *Kharif Crops.*—Among food grain crops, the estimated outturn of rice and *jowar* ranged between 50 and 92 per cent. of the normal and of *bajri* between 50 and 83 per cent. of the normal in the Province except in Bijapur district where it was only about 22, 13 and 17 per cent. of the normal respectively. Sesamum yielded between 42 per cent. of the normal and a full normal except in Bijapur district where it returned only about 17 per cent. of the normal. The yield of cotton varied from 43 to 78 per cent. of the normal except in Bijapur district where it came to about 21 per cent. of the normal.

13. *Rabi Crops.*—The outturn of wheat ranged between 50 and 80 per cent. of the normal, of *jowar* between 33 and 75 per cent. of the normal and of gram between 47 and 92 per cent. of the normal in the Province except Bijapur district where the yield of each of these crops was as low as 17 per cent. of the normal. Among oil-seeds linseed returned between 33 and 83 per cent. of the normal except in Bijapur district where it yielded only about 13 per cent. of the normal, while in the case of rape and mustard the outturn varied from 33 to 81 per cent. of the normal. The yield of tobacco ranged between 50 and 77 per cent. of the normal except in Bijapur district where it was only 8 per cent. of the normal. Sugarcane which is a perennial crop returned between 46 per cent. of the normal and a full normal yield.

14. *Cotton.*—As regards the actual outturn of cotton as estimated by the number of bales, it may be stated that so far as the area factor in the Bombay Province

including Indian States is concerned, there was a big decrease of 20,06,000 acres or by 32.8 per cent. when compared with the previous year. Thus the total area stood at 41,01,000 acres during the year under report as against 61,07,000 acres in the preceding year. The total outturn in the Province including Indian States also showed a corresponding set back of 3,82,000 bales or by 34.0 per cent., i.e., from 11,25,000 bales in the previous year to 743,000 bales during the year under report. Out of the total area of 41,01,000 acres, 429,000 acres were cultivated under the short stapled varieties of cotton while the remaining 36,72,000 acres were under medium and long stapled cottons. Similarly, out of the total outturn of 743,000 bales, 61,000 bales represented the yield of short stapled cotton, while the remaining 682,000 bales belonged to the medium and long stapled varieties of cotton.

CHAPTER VI—PRICES.

(Table VI, pages 54-55.)

15. The following remarks indicate the major variations in the average prices, prevailing at harvest time, of the principal articles as compared with those of the previous year.

The average price of rice ruled higher by about one seer to two and three-fifth seers per rupee, of wheat by about three and one-third seers to nearly four and half seers per rupee, of jowar by about four and one-sixth to nearly eight and one-sixth seers per rupee, and of bajri by about three and three-fifth to about seven seers per rupee in all the Divisions of the Province. The average price of tur-dal was dearer by about two and half seers to nearly three and half seers per rupee, of gram by about three and one-seventh seers to nearly three and three-fourth seers per rupee and that of nachni by about four seers to nearly seven seers per rupee. The average price of *gur* rose from about two and half seers to nearly four and one-fourth seers per rupee, while that of tobacco showed only slight variations in places.

The following table compares the prices of Broach cotton ruling at Bombay during the year under report with those of the previous year and the average of the preceding five years. The price of jarila cotton at Bombay has also been given this year as prices of Khandesh and Kumta descriptions of cotton (for which prices were quoted in previous years) were not available during the year under report, these being not tenderable under the new Indian Cotton Contract :—

It will be seen from the above table that the price of Broach cotton showed an abnormal rise over that of the previous year and also over the average price of the

preceding five years mainly due to the war situation. In the subjoined table the prices of Broach cotton ruling at Bombay have been given for those months for which they were available : —

The average price of dry grass ruled higher from about six and half annas to nearly one rupee and two and half annas per Indian Maund, and of *jowari kadbi* from about six annas to nearly one rupee and eleven annas per Indian Maund. The price of rice straw in the Konkan showed only slight variations.

CHAPTER VII—AGRICULTURAL STOCK.

16. Information under this head is collected once in five years. The result of the last enumeration has been published in the Season and Crop Report for the year 1939-40.

CHAPTERS VIII and IX—CONDITION OF THE AGRICULTURAL POPULATION.

17. As already stated in Chapter I of the Report the season under review was on the whole fairly satisfactory over a large part of the Bombay Province and but for the failure of the late monsoon which resulted in an unfortunate decrease in the outturn of both *kharif* and *rabi* crops especially the latter, the season would have been a really good one. In the eastern regions of the South Deccan and Karnatak the inadequate and irregular precipitation during the season caused considerable reduction in anticipated crops returns particularly in the eastern areas of the Karnatak where famine conditions prevailed. This necessitated the declaration of the existence of " Scarcity " and " famine " conditions in some of these tracts and also liberal grants of remissions and suspensions and the commencement of relief works to alleviate the distressing situation.

Taking the Province as a whole there was an appreciable increase in the food crop production during the year under report as compared with the previous year. As a result there was a general sufficiency of food and fodder over the greater part of the Province except in the eastern areas of the South Deccan and the whole of the eastern tract of the Karnatak where in view of the unfavourable character of the season there was a shortage of food and fodder and the situation was rather aggravated as there were no sufficient stocks held over from the harvest of the previous year which was also a scarcity year in these tracts. The following tabular statement compares the actual acreage sown and the estimated tonnage of

food grain crops produced in different Divisions of the Province during the years 1941-42 and 1942-43 :—

The above table indicates that excepting in the Karnatak which exhibited a set back, both the acreage and the total yield of food grain crops in the other Divisions showed an appreciable improvement over the preceding year.

18. During the year under report, the economic conditions resulting from the World War continued to influence the prices of agricultural products which maintained their upward trend. This movement was aggravated by local internal disturbances and by pressure on transport facilities. In addition, there is little doubt that speculation in and hoarding of food grains and other commodities, combined with the general uncertainty of the War situation, contributed considerably to the rise in prices of agricultural produce, particularly food-grains. Government took important and widespread measures to check food hoarding and other anti-social actions, to regulate food prices and to ensure equitable distribution of available food stocks throughout the Province and among all classes of the community. This action on the part of Government, supplemented fortunately by an improved War situation, helped considerably to restore public confidence and had a stabilising effect on prices of agricultural products.



19. The condition of cattle was generally satisfactory. Hæmorrhagic Septicæmia, rinderpest, foot and mouth and not other animal diseases prevailed as usual but did not assume such proportions as to seriously interfere with the normal progress of agricultural operations.

20. Owing to the intensification of war efforts there was a large demand for labour for various Military works and the wages of agricultural labour, therefore, exhibited an upward tendency as compared with those ruling during the previous year.
