## BOARD OF REVENUE, BIHAR.

### RESOLUTION.

Dated Patna, the 9th July 1936.

THE stamp statistics for the year 1935-36 for the old province of Bihar and Orissa have been compiled in the prescribed statements I-VII.

2. *Statement I.*—The revenue under the Stamp and Court-fees Acts amounted to Rs. 1,17,45,274 against Rs. 1,14,17,379 in the preceding year showing a total increase of Rs. 3,27,895. The total charges were Rs. 3,03,722 against Rs. 3,01,368 of the last year. The net revenue stood at Rs. 1,14,41,552 in the year 1935-36, an increase of Rs. 3,25,541 over the previous year.

3. *Statement II.—Judicial Stamps.*—The total receipts in 1935-36 showed an increase of Rs. 2,65,459 compared with the figures of the preceding year. There was a net increase of Rs. 2,58,116 in the receipts from the sale of Court-fee stamps and of Rs. 7,595 from the sale of stamps for copies. The increase in revenue was general excepting the districts of Darbhanga, the Santal Parganas, Sambalpur, Palamau and Manbhum and was due to the institution of a larger number of rent suits and other cases and suits of higher value and also to the Dhalbhum Settlement in Singhbhum. The decrease of Rs. 19,258 in Darbhanga, Rs. 1,979 in Palamau and Rs. 7,461 in Manbhum was due to smaller number of suits instituted while that of Rs. 12,050 in the Santal Parganas and of Rs. 2,280 in Sambalpur is attributed to fall in the institution of money suits owing to general trade depression and scarcity of money.

4. *Statement III.—Non-Judicial Stamps.*—There was a net increase of Rs. 62,436 in the receipts from the sale of non-judicial stamps. The increase was shared by all the districts except Shahabad, Bhagalpur, Monghyr, Purnea, Puri and Muzaffarpur owing to increase in the number of documents registered and licenses issued under the Motor Vehicles Taxation Act as well as to the number of legal practitioners enrolled in Patna and in Orissa. The increase in Palamau is attributed to a larger number of documents executed on account of general economic depression and in Manbhum to the introduction of revenue stamps and execution of a larger number of documents. The decrease of Rs. 10,904 in Monghyr, of Rs. 24,593 in Bhagalpur and of Rs. 810 in Purnea was due to lesser demands for non-judicial stamps and also for legal practitioners stamps in Bhagalpur. The decrease of Rs. 7,489 in Muzaffarpur is ascribed to the decrease in the sale of non-judicial stamps owing to the dullness of the money market and of Rs. 3,671 in Puri to the depression in the value of lands in consequence of which the consideration money on which stamp duty was payable, fell. No explanation has been furnished for the decrease of Rs. 16,389 in Shahabad.

5. *Statement IV.—Arrangements for the sale of stamps.*—The total number of vendors for the sale of stamps during the year was 1,064 or five more than in the preceding year. There was a decrease in the Tirhoot and Ori sa divisions and increase in the others. The increase of Rs. 2,096 in the discount allowed was due to increase in stamp revenue.

6. *Statement V.—Punitive action taken by the courts and by Revenue Officers.*—The total number of cases in which deficit duty and penalty were levied by the Civil Courts during the year was 1,459 against 1,341 in 1934-35 with a decrease of Rs. 201 in the amount of duty and penalty. There was an increase of 45 in the number of cases decided and of Rs. 1,418 in the amount
