SIR,

I AM directed to submit the annual returns relating to the collection of Income-Tax for the year ending the 31st March 1906, which have been prepared in the forms prescribed in Government of India Resolution No. 5430 S. R., dated 4th September 1903. As a full Triennial Report (for the period 1902-05) was submitted last year, no attempt will be made to examine the figures in detail.

2. The total net collections (column 23 of Return III) show an increase from Rs. 12,18,905 to Rs. 12,31,792. Columns 14 and 15 of the same return show a slight decrease in the number of assessees with an increase in the amount of tax. Column 21 of return V shows an increase in the amount uncollected at the close of the year, as compared with that at the close of the previous year—Rs. 21,117 and Rs. 19,886. But column 19 of the same statement shows collections of Rs. 18,484 on account of the balances of 1904-05, and no doubt the greater part of those of the past year have since been realised. The details of the arrears by districts are given in column 21 of statement VI; and it will be seen that Delhi, Lahore, Shahpur and Lyallpur are responsible for the greater part of them. Special inquiry will be made with regard to these districts. The entries in columns 12 and 13 of this statement against the Lyallpur District should, apparently, have come into columns 10 and 11; but it has not been possible to clear the matter up in time.
