SIR,

I HAVE the honour to submit my annual report on the consumption of Stationery and Rubber Stamps in the offices under the Government of the Punjab during the year 1927-28.

2. The revised estimate of Rs. 4,42,600 for stationery to be obtained from the Central Stores, Calcutta, was intimated in your letter No. 27861-F-Genl., dated the 3rd November 1927. Additional grants to the extent of Rs. 38,000 and Rs. 10,975 were also sanctioned in your memorandum No. 9698-F, dated the 19th March 1928, and letters Nos. 10197-F. G., 14667-F. G. and 4782-F., dated the 30th March 1928, 10th May 1927 and 9th February 1928 respectively.

The total allotment for the year was therefore Rs. 4,91,575 out of which Rs. 4,72,216 was distributed amongst the officers and the presses as detailed below:—

3. The total expenditure on account of stationery and rubber stamps supplied during the year under report was Rs. 4,46,828 against the distributed allotment of Rs. 4,72,216 as summarised below, resulting in a saving of Rs. 25,388 which was mainly due to decreased demands.
