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

# Public Works Department, Punjab.

## *REPORT by the Examiner of Public Works Accounts, Punjab, on the Finance Accounts, Municipal funds for the year 1888-89.*

As originally sanctioned, the budget grant for outlay during the year was Rs. 9,21,861, but by subsequent additions and reductions, resulting in a net transfer of Rs. 67,215 from the Civil Department (*vide Appendix D.*), it was increased to Rs. 9,89,076.

2. The expenditure of the year amounted to Rs. 7,06,224; so that, as shewn in the following table, there were savings of Rs. 2,15,637 and Rs. 2,82,852, on the original and final grants respectively—

5. The actual short outlay on original works as against the final grant, was Rs. 2,03,869, and nearly 81 per cent. of this large lapse occurred under Miscellaneous Public Improvements.

6. The expenditure under Original Works this year shows a decrease of Rs. 47,435, as compared with the expenditure during 1887-88, and almost the whole of this short outlay may be said to be due to the Town Hall at Simla, as owing to its being practically completed during 1887-88, there was only a small expenditure of Rs. 4,605 during the year on the original estimate, as compared with an outlay of Rs. 50,558 during the previous year.

7. Appendix A shows that eleven works, estimated to cost above Rs. 2,500, and fifty-two costing between that amount and Rs. 750, were completed during the year.

#### REPAIRS.

8. The final grant under this head stands at Rs. 3,64,503, being a net increase of Rs. 20,590 over the original grant of Rs. 3,43,913. The expenditure was Rs. 2,90,541, showing savings of Rs. 53,372 and Rs. 73,962 on the original and final grants, respectively. Of this large saving against the final grant Rs. 62,853 (or nearly 85 per cent.) lapsed under Miscellaneous Public Improvements, and occurred principally on "Town Buildings, &c." "Paving Streets," and "Sewerage and Drainage."

9. The most important lapses in the repair grant occurred in the following districts :—

10. The grant and outlay of the year are contrasted with similar figures for the previous four years in the subjoined statement, from which it will be seen that the expenditure of the year was Rs. 12,981 less than that of 1887-88, and that the whole of the short outlay was under "Miscellaneous Public Improvements," as the saving under "Civil Buildings" is almost identical with the excess under Communications.

#### ESTABLISHMENT.

11. All charges on account of establishment fall under the head "Construction." The grant finally stood at Rs. 32,520, and the expenditure against it amounted to Rs. 28,585, or a little over 4·22 per cent. of the outlay of the year on works and repairs.

12. The grant, outlay and percentage of the year, and similar figures for the four preceding years are, for purposes of comparison, exhibited in the annexed statement, which shews that, as contrasted with 1887-88, there has been an excess outlay in this year of Rs. 1,063. This, however, calls for no special remark.
